

STATUTORY DECLARATION OF BIRTHRIGHT CITIZENSHIP AND COVENANT STANDING

1. BIRTH AND CITIZENSHIP

I was born within Canada and therefore am a citizen by birth under the Canadian Citizenship Act and protected by the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms. My rights to life, liberty, and security of the person (Charter s.7) are inherent and not dependent upon any political party or policy.

2. COVENANT STANDING

I acknowledge that my life and birth are a gift from YHWH, the God of Israel. As it is written, “He made of one blood all nations of men to dwell on all the face of the earth.” (Acts 17:26)

My identity and worth come from Him, and no earthly authority can take away that divine heritage.

3. EQUAL PROTECTION AND NON-DISCRIMINATION

I affirm that every citizen is entitled to equal protection and equal benefit of the law without discrimination (Charter s.15).

No immigration policy, foreign agreement, or administrative decree can diminish the status or rights of birthright citizens.
